



Sierra Wildflowers Moderate to Wet Mix

Mix 1" of compost into soil to a depth of 4-6". Broadcast seeds and gently rake into soil to a depth of 1/8-1/4". Tamp seed bed to press seeds into soil and cover with 1/4" of light mulch. Keep soil continually moist throughout germination, approximately 3 weeks. When sprouts are about 1" tall, water 3 times a week during the first growing season, less thereafter. Some flowers will not bloom until the second growing season. To promote successful germination, sow seeds right before persistent snow cover or in the spring.
