These workshops teach contractors and homeowners how to install BMPs, which are required in the Tahoe Basin. By popular demand, we are offering two separate workshops again this year, both just before the busy construction season begins (see following pages for details).

Licensed contractors who successfully complete either workshop can have their business contact information listed in the BMP Installation Service Providers List. This will let owners of single-family homes know that these contractors have been trained to install TRPA-required BMPs on such properties. However, neither these workshops nor this list constitute any kind of "TRPA Certification" of your business. The BMPs that you install must pass a final inspection before TRPA will issue a Certificate of BMP Completion.

Whether you attend on April 16 or April 23, you will:

- Find out how construction and landscaping activities can contribute to water pollution in Lake Tahoe and how to install BMPs as recommended in a BMP Site Evaluation.
- Become familiar with new developments in the BMP Retrofit Program at Lake Tahoe.
- Review current guidelines for integrating defensible space with best management practices.
- Meet with vendors from the erosion control and BMP industries (April 16 only).
